I first started work in Oldham for the Local Authority in 2004 in the Business Support team supporting School Improvement and ICT services for Oldham schools. My roles involved providing a high level of administrative support as well as managing service budgets.

Following this, I was the Assistant Complaints Officer for Children's Services. This involved handling complaints and concerns from parents, carers and young people about all the services the council offers in respect of children and young people, as well as supporting parents to access the school complaints system.
