


Autumn Term Updates

Applications for Reception places

The deadline is fast approaching for parents/carers to submit applications for children born between 1st September 2020 and 31st August 2021 to apply for their Reception place.

To apply you simply need to complete an application form online which is available on the Oldham Council website. It's quick and easy and ensures school offers can be made efficiently via e-mail.

Applications can ONLY be made online.

When you apply you will:

Get an instant acknowledgement that your application has been received.

Be sent a confirmation email when you press the submit button.

Receive the outcome of your application by email or by logging into your account.

If you are unable to access the internet from home, computers are available at a number of local libraries.
