Fuel for Learning: Enjoy Nutritious School Meals!

A healthy meal can make a big difference in your child's focus and energy at school. Our school meal programme offers delicious, balanced and affordable meals every day, ensuring students get the nutrients they need to learn and thrive.

Tasty and Nutritious Options for example:

Meatballs and Pasta, Chicken Dinner and Fish Fingers. Each day, children will be asked at registration what they would like to order that day.

Convenient and Affordable:

No need to shop and make a lunch; we've got it covered at a cost of £2.70 per day or £13.50 a week.

Supports Learning:

Proper nutrition helps with concentration, memory, and overall well-being.

All children in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 are able to access a school meal at no cost to parents/carers, regardless of income due to The Universal Infant Free School Meal scheme.

Free School Meals are available to children from families on a low income. If you think that you may qualify for means tested Free School Meals, you should apply to Oldham Council to check.
