The Daily Mile is an activity that children in schools participate in across the world.

The aim of The Daily Mile, is to improve the physical, social, emotional and mental health and wellbeing of our children, regardless of age, ability or personal circumstances.

During their school day, each class takes part in the playground. This is a 'mile' of jogging or running, which allows the children to have a break from the classroom and is a fully inclusive, free and simple initiative which improves the physical and mental health of the children in our school.

It is also a social activity and has been proven to improve focus in the classroom. Each class takes part at different times of the day, depending on their timetable and when the children are in need of some movement and a 'brain break'.

It takes place in 15 minutes with most children averaging a mile, or more. The children are outside in the fresh air, it's social, non-competitive and fun.
